**RESOLUTION FOR THE UTILITY RADIOLOGICAL SAFETY BOARD
REQUESTING FENOC CONSIDER COMMENTS TO FENOC NORM-LP-5002,
"RELEASE IN PROGRESS POSITION"**

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 4937 creates the Utility Radiological Safety Board of Ohio (the Board) composed of the Emergency Management Agency, the Department of Health, the Public Utilities Commission, the Environmental Protection Agency, the Department of Agriculture, and the Department of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, the Board's purpose as stated in ORC Section 4937.02(A) include an objective to recommend policies and practices that promote safety, performance, emergency preparedness and public health standards that are designed to meet the State's needs; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has met with FirstEnergy Nuclear Operating Company (FENOC) representatives to discuss NORM-LP-5002.

NOW THEREFORE, the Utility Radiological Safety Board requests FENOC consider the following comments as appropriate revisions to the current NORM-LP-5002, FENOC position on "Release in Progress" for Emergency Response Organization:

1. That a definition for "routine release" be included in the definitions, Section 3.0,
2. The term "radioactivity" be replaced with the term "radioactive material" in Section 4.5. Additionally, that this terminology be considered for upcoming revisions to both the initial and follow-up notification forms.
